7:40 am	Arrive at Edinburgh Airport Meet your drivers and tour director who will be with you for the duration of your tour.
9:00 am	Depart Edinburgh Airport for Glasgow. (final departure time subject to individual flight schedules).
10:30 am	Arrive in <i>Glasgow City</i> and take some free time to go museum-hopping, shopping, or maybe read a book in a coffee shop while you take in your first impressions of this energetic, modern city layered with history.

10:00 am	En-route we'll stop at the <i>Falkirk Wheel</i> . Made famous by its extraordinary engineering feat, Falkirk Wheel connected the Forth and Clyde Canal with the Union Canal in 2002, for the first time in nearly 70 years, by creating the world's only rotating boat lift.
10:45 am	Depart Falkirk Wheel for Stirling
11:30 am	Visit <i>Stirling Castle</i> , the childhood home of Mary Queen of Scots, and one of the largest and most historically, architecturally significant castles in Scotland.
1:00 pm	Lunch at your own expense at the Unicorn Cafe in Stirling Castle.
2:00 pm	Depart Stirling
2:30 pm	Visit <i>The Kelpies</i> monument in Falkirk. This pair of monumental steel horse-heads is located in the Helix park between the Scottish towns of Falkirk and Grangemouth. Standing tall at over an impressive 30 meters, their overwhelming statue presence is reminiscent of their huge place in Scottish folklore.

6:45 pm	Depart Clayton Hotel Glasgow for dinner in the West End tonight
7:00 pm	Dinner in <i>Van Winkle (West End)</i> tonight for some proper Scottish pub grub.

10:00 am	Visit Edinburgh's most historic and striking landmark, <i>Edinburgh Castle</i> . Standing tall since the 11th century, Edinburgh Castle served as a royal



	residence for approximately 600 years. Complete with a chapel constructed in the 12th century, museums, halls, mega-cannons, and jewels, this is truly a royal visit.
1:00 pm	Lunch at your own expense either in the <i>Redcoat Cafe</i> or elsewhere in Edinburgh.
2:00 pm	Day at leisure in Edinburgh! Dinner on your own this afternoon (picking up snacks for after the concert during this time too)
4:30 pm	Truck arrives at St. Giles' Cathedral and <i>members return</i> for preparation and truck unloading for concert.
5:00 pm	Setup and rehearsal for concert in the historic <i>St. Giles' Cathedral</i> . This church has been in operation for almost 900 years; it has seen wars, events for Parliament, and the royal Order of the Thistle ceremonies, but all throughout its history it's served as a pillar of the general community as well.
6:50 pm	Rehearsal and preparation finishes for a quick break while audience files in

7:30 pm	Evening performance in St. Giles' Cathedral.
9:00 pm	Load equipment truck with all relevant instruments and equipment for safekeeping and transit to Ireland.

- 12:45 pm Experience the staggering *Cliffs of Moher*, Ireland's most visited natural attraction. They stretch for 8km (5 miles) and reach 214m (702 feet) at their highest point north of O'Brien's Tower, where you can enjoy unrivalled views of the Atlantic Ocean.
